# **ABEL**

Hebrews 11: 4

## **BIBLE READING PLAN:**

#### Read Hebrews 11: 4

· What are the **key phrases** that stand out to you in this passage?

#### Read Genesis 4: 3-6

- · As you read this passage, ask Holy Spirit to help you with personal revelation through the following phrases and what they might mean:
  - a. "At the designated time" (v 3)
  - b. Abel brought "the best portions" of the firstborn lambs from his flock. (v 4)
  - c. "You will be accepted if you do what is right." (v 7)
  - d. "Sin is crouching at the door, eager to control you." (v 7)

#### Read Matthew 23: 23-28

- · What do you think Jesus is teaching us by mentioning the tithing of the Pharisees?
- · Are there areas of your life that look good on the outside, but not so good on the inside?

#### Read 2 Samuel 24: 24

- · In the context of this chapter, what is David teaching us about making an offering?
- · How can you translate this into your lifestyle of worship?

## ADDITIONAL READING:

#### Read Hebrews 11: 17-19 and Genesis 22: 1-18

· Consider what you might *learn about faith* through these two additional passages.

## PERSONAL DEVOTION PLAN:

Now without faith it is impossible to please him, for the one who approaches God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

Hebrews 11: 6

Read Hebrews 11 again, (this time, try a different translation) What are ways that you find it effective to "approach God"? How can you practice this during your week?

- · How can we encourage others in faith, as the stories of Hebrews 11 encourage us?
