### TAMARIKI TIPU



**Growing Children**  
Every child deserves to be seen, valued, and supported. Strong school, whanau, and community partnerships foster wellbeing, resilience, and belonging - empowering tamariki to thrive.

Tamariki Tipu is a partnership between Te Awamutu Bible Chapel (TABC) and Te Awamutu Primary School (TAPS) within the 24-7 YouthWork Network (24-7YW). This presence-based model is designed to see all children thrive.

Two Youth Workers are employed for 10 hours each of paid work on average per week during the school terms. This is supported by at least five volunteer hours each week.

Church volunteers are reading with children, supervising swimming, supporting staff, manning the sick bay, maintaining bikes, building projects around school and making crafts with kids at lunchtime.
